City of St. Marys Residents

The City of St. Marys Clean-Up day is scheduled for May 18, 2019 from 8:00 am – 2:00 pm at the City Street Garage on Graphite Road. Residents will need to abide by the following:

- St. Marys Residents only
- **NO DUMPING PERMITTED BEFORE 8:00 am ~ Cameras on site to catch violators**
- Car and passenger truck tires will be accepted from residents, only, no businesses
- Cost to recycle tires will be \$2.00/tire
- No electronics will be accepted; the Elk County Community Recycling Center will be open to accept electronics and small appliances from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm
- No Hydraulic truck bed dumping is permitted
- Please restrict the use of trailers
- Items must be able to be hand-dumped by residents
- Cooperation with site workers

Tires (passenger car and truck) \$2.00/tire

Large Household items i.e. Plastic Lawn Furniture, Household furniture, bedding

*White Goods, i.e. Refrigerators, Freezers, Washers, Dryers, Water Heaters

*Car and Truck Batteries
